Once again, I am very thankful and grateful to you for the 'Trojan work' in the preparation for the great event we had in the diocese on 27th August, 2016 as you welcomed me as the Bishop of Mzuzu Diocese. Let the spirit displayed in those preparations continue to direct our efforts as we continue with the ministry of God.

3 FOOD ASSISTANCE TO ST PATRICK'S SEMINARY

May I appeal to all parishes to contribute 4 bags of maize (50kg) or its equivalent in monetary form to alleviate the food situation. I thank you for your usual assistance. Apart from the above mentioned items, feel welcome to add other items which you feel may assist our seminarians.

4 ACCOUNTABILITY

In our meeting held on 30th August, 2016, the issue of ACCOUNTABILITY featured highly. The issue resurfaced during parish pastoral visits. It is also surfacing here in Germany. Yesterday, during my first day here, I visited two partners, 1) Rottenburg Diocese and 2) Cologne Archdiocese ----both have told me that Mzuzu Diocese has projects which have not yet submitted reports which are long overdue and without these final reports, Mzuzu Diocese cannot access further funding. But if we resolve these issues doors will be opened. We need a change of mindset on this issue at all levels. I appeal to all to ensure that there is only one reporting system in the parish that can be traced from small Christian communities to Substation level, proceeding to Outstations, Zones up to the Parish Centre. Parish Finance Committees will receive proper induction and should make sure that there is transparency and accountability at all levels. The FIAO and his team will make follow up visits to monitor the situation.

5 FEASIBILITY STUDIES TO ESTABLISH NEW PARISHES


A team consisting of the *Vicar General (VG)*; *Finance, Investment and Administration Officer (FIAO)* and the *Pastoral Secretary (PS)* will visit Embangweni in Mzimba, Kabulufu in Rumphu and Kasitu in Nkhata-Bay to determine the feasibility of establishing a parish in each of these places and advise the bishop on how to proceed. Among the stakeholders to be involved are traditional leaders, parish council leaders, local church leaders and priests and sisters.

I would like to inform the newly appointed priests to take their new offices by the 22nd of October. As the practice has been, prepare handovers which include financial statements that are reflective of the bank statements. Only written handovers signed by the finance team will suffice the smooth process of passing on the authority to the incoming team.
